Checklist Items:

- ☐ **1. Define Objectives & Success Metrics**

Select tools that align with your specific workflow needs, focusing on integration with your CMS and reliable API access. Conduct short trials to evaluate tool effectiveness and integration ease.

Create guidelines for content quality and governance to ensure that automation does not compromise editorial control. Define review processes for sensitive stages.

Start by automating low-risk pipeline stages, such as topic clustering and metadata generation. Maintain manual review for critical steps such as final sign-off.

After implementation, track the predefined KPIs to assess the effectiveness of automation. Make iterative adjustments based on data to improve workflow continuously.
