Utilize grower forums and community platforms to gather real-life experiences and phenohunt reports, focusing on photos and detailed harvest notes.

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☐ 7. Assess Genetic Risks

Consider potential genetic issues such as disease traits or stability concerns, reflecting on any reported weaknesses from multiple sources.

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☐ 8. Make an Informed Purchase Decision

With gathered data, weigh the benefits and risks of each strain to finalize which genetics to purchase based on your evaluation.

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
